Goal of Festival Pageant: To have fun, make new friends, and gain pageant experience.

Age Divisions:*

Girls: 0 - 11 months (Baby Miss) 12 - 23 months (Toddler Miss) 2 - 3 (Wee Miss) 4 - 5 (Tiny Miss)

6 – 7 (Little Miss) 8 – 10 (Junior Miss) 11 – 12 (Pre-teen) 13 – 15 (Teen) 16 – 18 (Miss)

19-21 (Collegiate Miss) 0-21 (Special Needs)

Boys: 0-3 years (Baby Mister) 4-6 (Wee Mister) 7-11 (Little Mister) 0-21 (Special Needs)

Entry Rules:

- Contestants must fall into one of the age categories to compete.
- All contestants must have a permanent residence in Estill County. College/international students can participate if parents/host parents reside in Estill County.
- Contestants must be single, never married and never had children.

Entry Fee:

- The pageant entry fee is \$15.00 on or before Friday, April 14. Between Monday, April 17 and Saturday, April 22 the entry fee will be \$25.
- Make checks payable to Mountain Mushroom Festival.
- No applications will be accepted without the entry fee.

Competition Dress:

- Introduction: Contestants will wear a white self-provided t-shirt or shirt. It may be custom decorated with a mushroom theme and worn with jeans or capris, not skirts or shorts, and shoes of your choice.
- Walk-Through: Contestants will wear Sunday best or semi-formal.

Judging Criteria:

- Babies and Toddlers (Ages $\theta 3$ years:
 - 1. Overall
 - 2. Appearance
 - 3. Demeanor
 - 4. Stage Presence
- Ages 4 21:

The judging will be based on a 40 point scoring system as follows:

- 1. 10 points: Poise
- 2. 10 points: Eye Contact with judges and crowd
- 3. 10 points: Appearance (hair and makeup should be age appropriate)
- 4. 10 points: How well you speak when introducing yourself and answering the on stage question. (Contestants will be asked to answer a general question on demand but will not be judged on

the answer, only on the way in which you conduct yourself when speaking.) The judges will be from out of town and carefully selected. Judges decisions are final.

Contest Prizes:

• Each age division will have a winner, first runner-up, and second runner-up. The winners will receive a crown and sash. First runner-up Princes and Princesses will receive a trophy. The second runner-up Princes and Princesses will receive a medallion.

General Rules:

- Contestants will be disqualified for any breaking of rules or unsportsmanlike conduct without a refund of entry fee money. This decision will be at the committee's discretion.
- If for some reason the winner of any category cannot fulfill the responsibilities of the title, then the first runner-up will preside.
- Winners, age 4 and older, will be expected to wear their crown and sash throughout the festival and participate in various events during the weekend. Winners will also be expected to participate in the festival parade on Saturday, April 29 at 1 p.m.
